Under-appreciated perennials

Most Alliums bloom in late Spring, Allium sphaerocephalon starts blooming in early Spring, around March to April. The Allium Sphaerocephalon looks a lot like the Allium Purple Sensation. The flowers return each year in the yard while the Allium Sphaerocephalon increases slowly. The Allium Sphaerocephalon naturalizes. This means if the Alliums are planted this year, next year, the plant has naturalized into more plants.
